

# Report from Students' Council

## December, 14<sup>th</sup> 2010

Dear colleagues,

on Tuesday 14 December 2010 students' representatives met to discuss some important topics concerning our life in SISSA. We will briefly summarize them for information purposes.

### 1. ELECTION OF THE STUDENTS' COUNCIL PRESIDENT AND OF THE REPRESENTATIVES IN THE COMMITTEES

Dario Bettoni (II year Astroparticle) will be the president of the students' council for two years. Moreover, we have a new representative for the security, Alessandro DiFilippo (I year, CNS), for the library, Eolo Di Casola (I year, Astrophysics) and for the computer resources (Riccardo Sabatini, II year, CM).

### 2. SISSA FORUM

In order to have the best match in communication among students, we decided to create a Forum where all the SISSA PhD students will access important information and will be free to express their points on the initiatives taken in our school.

### 3. ELECTORAL LAW

We started working at a new electoral law which may grant students having European citizenship the possibility to run for the administrative council; moreover, we would like to make elections each year (mandate of students' representative will always last two year, so every year we should renew only one charge) in order to guarantee a best interchange of duties and knowledge between the outgoing and incoming representatives.

### 4. OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

- b) The Gym should be ready in Spring time; this point strongly depends on a deal we are making with Administration.
